Promotion system: Time to get things straight!

- To kick-start promotions of officials recruited under the new Staff Regulations by 2006, our Union team worked out and proposed a '*pro rata temporis*' mechanism.
- The Court of Justice agreed to apply this mechanism, but only on an *exceptional* basis.



Particularités ou exceptions




- This important breakthrough, which made it possible to start climbing the career ladder as promised by the new StaffRegs, was in fact achieved by means of a *device* inserted into the pre-2004 setup.
- Without the '*pro rata temporis*' mechanism guaranteed rates cannot be implemented and, as a consequence, equivalence with the old career structure cannot be achieved.
- However, the '*situation on 1 January*', which traditionally determines the Institution's annual budgetary requests, is *not* the same thing as the simple application of the rate to the relevant number of staff re-

quired by Article 6 of the StaffRegs.
● To avoid the system collapsing, the Administration concedes, in a fragmentary and uncertain manner, ' <i>special</i> ' or ' <i>exceptional</i> ' measures ' <i>in favour of</i> ' new officials in the so-called ' <i>starting grades</i> '.
● One must recognise our Administration's art in presenting the staff's <i>rights</i> as a <i>gift</i> and in convincing even staff representatives that this is so...
● See, <i>eg</i> , an opinion of the Joint Promotions Committee (DG PerFin site), of which <i>our</i> Staff Committee (SC) members learnt by chance and long after its approval. Indeed, ' <i>sensitive</i> ' issues were neither discussed with all SC members nor notified to them. Yet another example of ' <i>transparency</i> '...

● To avoid wasting 2 more years, we must stop improvising and put in place a system which complies with the StaffRegs' structure, implementing the basic rule of Article 6, instead of treating officials recruited under the new StaffRegs' as an ' <i>exception to an exception</i> '.
● The SC is not ' <i>powerless</i> '. If the outgoing majority has been incompetent, it's up to you to elect a different one!*
