Town Council elections on 9 October 2011 — If you are entitled to vote, please exercise your right! Register now!

Decisions taken by Town Councils concern us all for several reasons.

The staff of European Institutions are often, erroneously, perceived as 'privileged' and existing in their own little world. As a consequence, we are subject to decisions taken by other people without being consulted.

Participating in local authority elections and showing that a significant number of 'Community' staff do vote in them may affect attitudes.

Our salary level is threatened by a forthcoming review of our Staff Regulations and our **purchasing power**, already weaker in Luxembourg than in Brussels, is shrunk by policy choices made locally. To mention just two fields:

- Housing is increasingly expensive, particularly for newly recruited colleagues.
- Public transport is insufficient, yet present policies indeed foster transport by private cars. Whether by choice or necessity, we shall have to confront this problem. Indeed,
  - In the near future the Court of Justice will be hit by a shortage of parking places.
  - Very influential local pressure groups are opposing the construction of a tramway line, a project already delayed and postponed for many years.
  - European School 2, which in 2012 will be established in Mamer Bertrange, will suffer from serious difficulties of school transport, including for young children, a problem unknown in Luxembourg.

For these and many other reasons, we call on our colleagues and members of their families who don't have Luxembourg nationality to **register** on the voters' lists of their Town.

## Requirements:

- Age: 18 years old on 9 October 2011, election day;
- Having been a resident in the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg for at least 5 years on the date of registration.

## Steps to follow:

Register on the voters' list at the Town Council of your place of residence by **14 July 2011**, at the latest, to be able to vote in the elections in October.
