 When recruited, officials are appointed to the grade set out in the notice of the competition they have passed.

 Recruitment of officials or engagement of temporary staff is effected, in principle, at the first step in their grade.

 On the basis of professional experience acquired and supported by appropriate evidence, classification is effected at the second step,
