

## Cross-border commuting and environmental policy: season-tickets for cross-border workers!

The particularly high cost of housing in Luxembourg ...

... is contributing to increasing the number of colleagues seeking housing beyond the borders of the Grand Duchy.

This further aggravates the problem of home-to-work travel, which is harmful

Travelling: 60% of the ECJ's EMAS carbon footprint → here

- both to the quality of life (time added to working time, stress, etc.) →
- ← and to the environment.



Home-to-work travel is part of your working conditions!

From 1 March 2020, **public transport** on the Luxembourg national network will be free of charge; no more need for an **mPass**!

The Luxembourg State is providing us with a significant benefit.

→ The Institution should also do its fair share! In which way?

Many **cross-border** colleagues will still have to pay for their season-tickets. The institution, which will be released in future from its contribution to the **mPass**, will have **to subsidize them** in a way that has yet to be specified.



**EPSU-CJ**, for its part, has set an example by making its own modest contribution! see  $\rightarrow$  <u>Season tickets</u>.

- → EPSU-CJ demands that the institution act in accordance with <u>its declared</u> environmental policy.
- → EPSU-CJ invites colleagues to vote for <u>all its 13 candidates</u> in the Cdp elections, thus providing a mandate to the newly elected Cdp to address the issues faced by cross-border commuters and to actively promote this demand.
